Asperger's syndrome, liens are factors in traffic case

\$800,000 Settlement

Defendant's trash truck pulled from a stop sign into the path of plaintiff's vehicle and caused a T-bone crash. Plaintiff suffered from Asperger's syndrome, and the defense contended that he failed to pay full time and attention at the time of the crash.

There were complex issues of Medicare and Medicaid liens that prohibited final settlement of the matter until June 2011. Counsel for plaintiff was assisted in resolving these issues by Garretson Resolution Group (Medicare lien and MSA) and attorney Kelly Thompson of Fairfax, who advised on the creation of a special needs trust. The trust was funded by structured settlement through Paul Brandt of Mesirow Financial.
